Summary

The Woodland Cultural Centre is seeking one highly motivated individual to assist in the Education department. The Cultural Interpreter assumes responsibility for guiding tours of the Woodland Cultural Centre's museum, facilitate Residential School presentations as well as workshop instructions. The Cultural Interpreter will be working in conjunction with other staff members to provide knowledgeable tours of the Centre and complete other duties related to Education. Preference will be given to applicants of First Nations ancestry.

July 23 – April 30 2019

\$16/hr. x 30 hours weekly

Key Responsibilities:

- Research and become familiar with Museum Education Department, the Cultural Centre's services.
- Research and become familiar with the traditional lifestyles and cultural objects.
- Conduct guided tours of the Centre; including the museum, art galleries
- Facilitate Museum Education workshops and presentations to public as requested, which may include craft workshops, traditional music/dance, sports; individually and cooperatively as needed.
- Present residential school information sessions
- Prep and maintain workshop materials.
- Be able to provide outreach presentations and workshops

Qualifications and Skills:

- Possess good oral and written communication skills
- Possess knowledge of Residential School, specifically Mohawk Institute.
- Have understanding of history of Six Nations and Haudenosaunee culture.
- Enjoy working with the public
- Reliable and demonstrate interpersonal and problem solving skills
- Understand the social and political context of the Woodland Cultural Centre Museum, Education program and Art galleries to First Nations
- Traditional craft and artistic ability an asset
- Knowledge of Haudenosaunee languages an asset
- Must be able to pass Vulnerable Sector Check
